Goals of the German Championship (WDM, number 3)

- Determination of the German champions in the mentioned disciplines.
- Setting records.
- Gaining knowledge about the formation of national teams and squads.
- Increase of competition experience, as well as exchange of experience in sports and technical aspects.
- Training and further education of referees (referee seminar before the DM).
- Promotion of young talents.
- Popularization of parachuting in the Federal Republic of Germany, including spectators, press, radio, television.
- Strengthening the camaraderie between parachutists.

Deviating from the ISC regulation, we count VFS as part of the discipline Artistry due to the identical target group.

Wingsuit Flying (WS): WS Acrobatics
WS Performance Time
WS Performance Distance
WS Performance Speed

Speed Skydiving (SP): SP (Men, Women, Juniors, Junior)
In Speed Skydiving there is an overall ranking from all categories
SP Test-Event (Mixed-Team: 2 participants of different sexes) after the official scoring)

Accuracy Landing (AL): Team Men, Team Women
Individual: men, women, masters, juniors, juniors

Additional venue of the discipline AL is the "swimming meadow" in 19053 Schwerin (at the Schwerin castle).

Style jumping (ST): Men, women, juniors, juniors

In the classic disciplines of Accuracy Landing and Style Jumping, there is a combination score from both competitions: Men, Women, Juniors, Junior

Scoring is possible after one complete round. In the discipline Accuracy Landing five rounds are required for a score.

Competition rules, starting order

The official rules of all disciplines can be found on the page <https://www.dfv.aero/Unser+Sport/Competitions/Competition-Rules>. The basis is the current Sporting Code of the FAI/ISC, General Part, Section 5 and the WDM as well as the current competition rules of the individual disciplines with the respective valid programs. For the purely national competition classes or categories (here especially the advanced, beginners and rookies) the rules and programs published on the federation website apply.

The starting order will be drawn by lot. As soon as it seems reasonable and possible for organizational reasons, jumping will be done in reverse order of placement. The decision on this will be made by the competition director.

Participation requirements

Each participant must be in possession of a valid pilot's license for air sports equipment pilots for parachutes or a comparable foreign qualification. Furthermore, a valid owner's liability insurance has to be proven. The current airworthiness documents of the parachute system used must be available.

Each participant must have a valid membership in the German Aero Club (DAeC) e.V. or the German Skydiving Association (DFV) e. V.

The membership number must be provided when registering electronically.

Participants who take part outside the DM competition do not have to prove membership in the DAeC or DFV.

Participation is limited to **two** competition classes for each competitor. This rule also applies to video jumpers.

Within a competition class (e.g. FS 4er, category(ies): open, women, advanced, beginner, rookie) only one category (one team) may be jumped.

The participants confirm with their registration the mentioned participation requirements. No qualification standards will be set for participation in the DM 2022.

Minimum number of participants and awarding of the title "German Champion"

A minimum number of four participating teams/competitors in the individual disciplines per competition class is required for the award of the title "German Champion". This also applies to the awarding of medals. One team per competition class is sufficient for a rating.

The title "German Champion" will be awarded for all categories of each competition class. In the test event Speed Skydiving no title "German Champion" will be awarded.

Medals, certificates

The top three finishers in each discipline, class and category will receive medals. Each competitor will receive a certificate.

The participants of the test event speed skydiving will each receive a certificate.

Registration and costs

Registration is possible online at www.dm2022.dfv.aero/Anmeldung only. Deadline for registration is **August 15, 2022**. Late registrations depend on the possibilities of the organizer and must be requested directly from the organization management.

The entry fee is **125 Euros per participant** for registrations received by July 31, 2022. For registrations after this deadline, the entry fee is **145 Euros per participant**. Participation in a further (second) competition class will be charged with an additional 20 Euros.

The entry fee includes the following:

- Eligibility for the competition
- Closing banquet
- T-shirt
- Goodie bag

The participants, who exclusively take part in the test event Speed-Skydiving only, have to pay a participation fee in the amount of **50 Euros per participant**.

The entry fee or the participation fee is to be paid by bank transfer for the entire team with the registration to the following account:

If a team/competitor does not show up for the competition after registration, a refund of the entry fee is not provided in principle. Exceptions will be decided by the organization management.

Training jumps before the start of the competition will be made according to the same price scale.

Ticket costs for all competition rounds are to be paid by the participants / teams on site before the start of the competition.

Repetition jumps are at the expense of the participants.

Schedule

DM preparation week with all-day training opportunities in all disciplines from at least one competition plane.

Sunday, 04.09.2022

19:00: General competition briefing, introduction of staff, presentation of the schedule, draw of the jumps FS 4s, VFS 2s and 4s, **discipline briefing for all competitions starting on Monday.**

Monday, 05.09.2022

From 08:00: Start of competition **FS 4er all categories, AE VFS 2er and 4er, CF 2er all classes, AE Freestyle, WS Performance, style jumping** according to the instructions of the competition director.

In the afternoon competition interruption for the official opening.

Tuesday, 06.09.2022

From 08:00 a.m.: Competition continuation **FS 4er all categories, AE VFS 2er and 4er, CF 2er all classes, AE Freestyle, WS Performance, style jumping** according to the instructions of the competition director.

20:00: General competition briefing, introduction of staff, presentation of the schedule, **discipline briefing for Speed Skydiving**, which will start on Wednesday.

Wednesday, 07.09.2022

From 08:00: Competition continuation **FS 4er all categories, AE VFS 2er and 4er, CF 2er all classes, AE Freestyle, WS Performance, Style Jumping, Speed Skydiving** as specified by the competition director.

Completion of the above competitions, start of the last plane no later than 19:00 (wheels off).

20:00: General competition briefing, introduction of the staff, presentation of the schedule, draw of the jumps FS 8s, CF 4s, **discipline briefing for all competitions starting on Thursday.**

20:30 "**INTERMEZZO**" party at the end of the first competitions.

Thursday, 08.09.2022

From 08:00: Start of the competition **FS 8er all categories, CF 4er all classes, AE Freefly, WS Acrobatic, Accuracy Landing, Speed-Skydiving** according to the instructions of the competition leader.

Friday, 09.09.2022

From 08:00: Competition continuation **FS 8er all classes, CF 4er all classes, AE Freefly, WS Acrobatic, Accuracy Landing, Speed-Skydiving** according to the competition leader. Accuracy Landing is planned on the "floating meadow" at the Schwerin castle.

Saturday, 10.09.2022

From 08:00: Competition continuation **FS 8er all classes, CF 4er all classes, AE Freely, WS Acrobatic, Accuracy Landing, speed skydiving** (including test event) as specified by the competition director, start of the last plane no later than 17:00 (wheels off).

Subsequently:

Award ceremony, closing banquet and closing party after official announcement of the results

Sunday, 11.09.2022

Departure of the participants

General information about the schedule

- According to the rules (Code Sportif Section 5, Skydiving, 5.2.1.) competitors are not allowed to perform skydives outside their competition or use a wind tunnel once their competition has started. Example: Competitors competing in FS 4er (start Monday) and FS 8er (start Thursday) may perform training jumps in 4er **and** 8er only until Sunday, Sept. 04, 2022.
- Organizational and weather-related changes of the planned schedule remain under reservation of the competition director.
- The test event Speed-Skydiving starts only after the completion of the official rating SP. All national and international participants can take part.

Dropping planes

For all competitions and disciplines **two** Cessna Caravan C208 B Supervan with identical jumper kits and one Cessna C182 RG are available.

For organizational reasons, all aircraft certified and suitable for dropping can be used for the competition.

For measurement and judging the ISC approved measurement and arbitration systems will be used. For organizational reasons, all suitable arbitration systems can be used for the competition.

Jury, protests, video panel, repeat jumps

The jury of the championship decides on protests. It is formed by all present members of the board of the BKF, unless the jury activity is in conflict with another exercised activity in the context of the competition. If the above mentioned are not available, the jury is not necessary. In this case, the College of Referees will make a final decision on any protests received. Protests must be submitted in writing and together with the fee to the competition director. The protest must be submitted no later than two hours after the publication of the result. The rules on which the protest is based must be mentioned. Referee decisions cannot be protested. Further details are given in the "FAI Sporting Code, Section 5 - Skydiving Class G - Parachuting and Indoor Skydiving".

The protest fee is 50 Euros.

If formations, intermediate maneuvers or the separation cannot be judged for weather reasons (e.g. clouds) or due to the video equipment (e.g. video failure), the video panel will decide on a repeat jump after considering the overall situation. The video panel consists of the competition director, the head referee and the national coach / coordinator. In case of manipulation, the jump will be scored with zero. Costs for ordered repetition jumps are always at the expense of the competitors.

Safety instructions / dropzone regulations

The host's house rules apply for the championships. A waiver must be filled out before the first jump. It is available at waiver.skydive-mv.de. Please send it after registration to:

DOPING controls

In accordance with the regulations of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) and the German Olympic Sports Confederation (DOSB), doping controls will also be carried out at this championship.

Other

1. We would like to point out that the names of alternates of a team have to be given in written form at the registration (at the latest until the beginning of the competition). Alternates of a team are only possible within the registered group of persons.
2. Please note that it is essential for a successful press and public relations work to have a residence information of each competitor and a designation of the home dropzone of each team. Please fill in the registration form early and completely.
